Created to reduce the gap between the industry and the students.

Our History

YHS began with the launch of the first Young Hoteliers Summit at the Ecole Hôtelière de Lausanne in 2010 as the first entirely student run hospitality Summit designed to reduce the gap between the hospitality industry, academic institutions and students from leading hotel management schools. At the same time, it created a platform for knowledge and idea exchange, networking opportunities and friendly competition.

YHS is the brainchild of 5 students from the graduating class of 2011; Rachel Crawford, Giovanni Forni, Christophe Oneyser, Youri Sawerschel and Anil Varghese. It has since grown into an integral event on the schedule of top hospitality management schools around the world – from 11 schools in 2010 to 40 in 2016, spanning all the continents.

Since then, the Young Hoteliers Summit has attracted the interest and support of top level industry players, from Kempinski to Shangri-La, Starwood to Fairmont, Four Seasons to Dorchester and many others including Expedia, Booking and STR Global. The year of 2017 will see the 8th edition being held with many new partners joining the discussion together with previous attendees.

The Team

The Young Hoteliers Summit team is made up of 39 EHL students, who take up the challenge of organizing this event from top to bottom. The selection process is entirely run by students, and so is the Summit itself.

From planning and welcoming more than 78 international delegates to financing and marketing, the Summit is the result of these students' motivation and ambition.




What is our aim?

YHS Rankings


The YHS Rankings (with Qualitra[™]) have become a world-wide recognized index of the top employers in the Hotel industry from Hospitality students' perspective.






Where?

Ecole Hôtelière de Lausanne

The Young Hoteliers Summit takes place every year at the Ecole Hôtelière de Lausanne. EHL is the leading institution in higher education in Hospitality Management and has been a reference in Switzerland and on a worldwide scale for over 120 years. As of today, EHL provides education to more than 3'000 students with over 90 nationalities. EHL offers three levels of degrees: a Bachelor of Science in International Hospitality Management, a Master of Science in Global Hospitality Business and an executive MBA in Hospitality Administration. EHL has established one of the largest and most dynamic professional networks of alumni around the world. This unique community consists of 25'000 industry leaders, all of them brought together by EHL's values and culture.



Lausanne

Lausanne, the second largest city on Lake Geneva and fifth largest city in Switzerland, combines a dynamic business energy with the peacefulness of a Swiss holiday spot. The capital of the canton of Vaud is also a lively university and convention city. As an Olympic capital, sports and culture have always inspired Lausanne in the wide range of activities offered by the city. The setting of Lausanne is extremely picturesque: it is hardly surprising that the International Olympic Committee has been based here since 1914. The town is built on three hills, surrounded by vineyard-covered slopes, with Lake Geneva at its feet. Rising impressively from the opposing French lakeshore are the Savoy Alps. 
